Ms. WILLIAMS of Georgia (for herself and Mrs. KIM) introduced the following
bill; which was referred to the Committee on Financial Services

A BILL

To continue the pause on disbursements and new financing
commitments to the Government of Burma.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.**

4 This Act may be cited as the “No New Burma Funds
5 Act”.

6 **SEC. 2. CONTINUATION OF PAUSE ON WORLD BANK DIS-**
7 **BURSEMENTS AND COMMITMENTS TO**
8 **BURMA.**

9 The Secretary of the Treasury shall direct the United
10 States Executive Director at the International Bank for

1 Reconstruction and Development to use the voice and vote
2 of the United States to continue the pause by the Bank
3 on disbursements and the making of new financing com-
4 mitments to the Government of Burma, which was initi-
5 ated after a military coup overthrew the democratically
6 elected Government of Burma in 2021, unless the Sec-
7 retary of the Treasury determines that it is not in the
8 public interest to do so.

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
