## A BILL

To provide that no Federal funds made available to U.S. Immigration and Customs Enforcement may be used, in carrying out any civil immigration enforcement activities under the immigration laws, to detain United States citizens or transport such citizens outside the United States, and for other purposes.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*  
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

1 **SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.**

2       This Act may be cited as the “Stop ICE from Kid-  
3 napping U.S. Citizens Act”.

4 **SEC. 2. LIMITATION ON USE OF FUNDS BY U.S. IMMIGRA-  
5 TION AND CUSTOMS ENFORCEMENT.**

6       Notwithstanding any other provision of law, no Fed-  
7 eral funds made available to U.S. Immigration and Cus-  
8 toms Enforcement may be used, in carrying out any civil  
9 immigration enforcement activities under the immigration  
10 laws (as such term is defined in section 101 of the Immi-  
11 gration and Nationality Act (8 U.S.C. 1101)), to—

- 12           (1) detain a citizen of the United States; or  
13           (2) transport a citizen of the United States out-  
14       side of the United States.
