A BILL

To prohibit the use of Federal funds to pay for a subscription to the Wall Street Journal for Members of Congress, and for other purposes.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.**

4 This Act may be cited as the “Stop Unnecessary Ex-
5 penditures Act” or the “SUE Act”.

6 **SEC. 2. PROHIBITION WITH RESPECT TO USE OF CERTAIN**
7 **FUNDS FOR WALL STREET JOURNAL SUB-**
8 **SCRIPTION.**

9 (a) IN GENERAL.—Notwithstanding any other provi-
10 sion of law, no Federal funds may be used to pay for a

1 subscription to the Wall Street Journal for any office of
2 a Member of Congress (including a Delegate or Resident
3 Commissioner to the Congress) or for any committee of
4 Congress.

5 (b) EFFECTIVE DATE.—This section shall apply with
6 respect to fiscal year 2025 and each succeeding fiscal year.

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
