A BILL

To amend the Energy Policy and Conservation Act to revise
the definition of showerhead.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.**

4 This Act may be cited as the “Saving Homeowners
5 from Overregulation With Exceptional Rinsing Act” or the
6 “SHOWER Act”.

7 **SEC. 2. REVISED DEFINITION OF SHOWERHEAD.**

8 (a) IN GENERAL.—Section 321(31)(D) of the Energy
9 Policy and Conservation Act (42 U.S.C. 6291(31)(D)) is
10 amended to read as follows:

11 “(D) The term ‘showerhead’ has the meaning
12 given such term in ASME A112.18.1–2024, except
13 such term does not include safety shower
14 showerheads.”.

15 (b) REVISIONS TO REGULATIONS.—Not later than
16 180 days after the date of enactment of this Act, the Sec-
17 retary of Energy shall promulgate such revisions to regu-
18 lations as may be necessary to conform such regulations
19 to the definition of showerhead in section 321(31)(D) of
20 the Energy Policy and Conservation Act, as amended by
21 subsection (a) of this section.
