A BILL

To amend the Foreign Assistance Act of 1961 to modify treatment activities for assistance to combat HIV/AIDS.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. MODIFICATION OF PREVENTION ACTIVITIES**

4 **FOR ASSISTANCE TO COMBAT HIV/AIDS.**

5 Section 104A(d) of the Foreign Assistance Act of
6 1961 (22 U.S.C. 2151b–2(d)) is amended—

7 (1) in paragraph (1)—

1 (A) in the matter preceding subparagraph
2 (A), by inserting “which shall be considered to
3 be core life-saving humanitarian assistance” be-
4 fore “including”;

5 (B) in subparagraph (J), by striking the
6 period at the end and inserting a semicolon;

7 (C) in subparagraph (K), by striking the
8 period at the end and inserting “; and”; and

9 (D) by adding at the end the following:

10 “(L) assistance to provide HIV pre-expo-
11 sure prophylaxis (PrEP) medications.”;

12 (2) in paragraph (2)—

13 (A) subparagraph (D), by adding “and” at
14 the end; and

15 (B) in subparagraph (E), by striking the
16 semicolon at the end and inserting a period;
17 and

18 (3) in paragraph (3)(A)—

19 (A) by inserting after “specific popu-
20 lations” the following: “(including at-risk popu-
21 lations in accordance with scientific-based anal-
22 ysis as designated by the World Health Organi-
23 zation)”;

24 (B) by striking “efforts to reduce the risk
25 of HIV/AIDS infection including” and inserting

1 “efforts to reduce the risk of HIV/AIDS infec-
2 tion which shall be considered to be core life-
3 saving humanitarian assistance, including pre-
4 and”; and

5 (C) by adding at the end before the period
6 the following: “, which shall be considered to be
7 core life-saving humanitarian assistance”.

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
