A BILL

To amend the Natural Gas Act to clarify the treatment of bunkering as an export, and for other purposes.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.**

4 This Act may be cited as the “Cutting LNG Bun-
5 kering Red Tape Act”.

6 **SEC. 2. TREATMENT OF BUNKERING.**

7 Section 3 of the Natural Gas Act (15 U.S.C. 717b)
8 is amended by adding at the end the following:

9 “(g) BUNKERING.—For purposes of this section, the
10 bunkering of natural gas for use by the receiving vessel

1 as marine fuel shall not be considered an export unless
2 the transfer of such natural gas to the receiving vessel
3 occurs in the territorial sea or inland waters of a foreign
4 country, regardless of the flag or country of registry of
5 either vessel.”.
