A BILL

To assign a resident inspector to certain commercial nuclear power plants to conduct inspections of decommissioning activities and spent nuclear fuel transfer activities.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.**

4 This Act may be cited as the “Increasing Nuclear
5 Safety Protocols for Extended Canister Transfers Act of
6 2025” or the “INSPECT Act of 2025”.

1 **SEC. 2. INSPECTION OF DECOMMISSIONING ACTIVITY AND**
2 **SPENT NUCLEAR FUEL TRANSFER ACTIVITY.**

3 (a) IN GENERAL.—The Nuclear Regulatory Commis-
4 sion shall assign, for the duration described in subsection
5 (b), a resident inspector to each commercial nuclear power
6 plant that has permanently ceased operation to conduct
7 inspections of decommissioning activities and spent nu-
8 clear fuel transfer activities of the commercial nuclear
9 power plant.

10 (b) DURATION DESCRIBED.—The duration described
11 in this subsection is the period of time it takes to transfer
12 all spent nuclear fuel from the spent fuel pools of the com-
13 mercial nuclear power plant to dry storage.

14 (c) REASSIGNMENT.—If there are no decommis-
15 sioning activities or spent nuclear fuel transfer activities
16 at the commercial nuclear power plant to which a resident
17 inspector is assigned under subsection (a), the Nuclear
18 Regulatory Commission may assign such resident inspec-
19 tor to other duties as may be appropriate.

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
