Ms. NORTON introduced the following bill; which was referred to the Committee on Oversight and Government Reform

A BILL

To amend title 40, United States Code, to require a majority of the members of the Commission of Fine Arts to be residents of the District of Columbia.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.**

4 This Act may be cited as the “Commission of Fine
5 Arts District of Columbia Residency Act”.

6 **SEC. 2. REQUIRING MAJORITY OF MEMBERS OF COMMIS-**
7 **SION OF FINE ARTS TO BE DISTRICT OF CO-**
8 **LUMBIA RESIDENTS.**

9 (a) REQUIREMENT.—Section 9101(b) of title 40,
10 United States Code, is amended by striking “appointed

1 by the President, who serve” and inserting “a majority
2 of whom are residents of the District of Columbia, who
3 shall be appointed by the President to serve”.

4 (b) EFFECTIVE DATE.—The amendment made by
5 subsection (a) shall take effect upon the expiration of the
6 1-year period which begins on the date of the enactment
7 of this Act.

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
