3 **SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.**

4 This Act may be cited as the “Empowering Law En-
5 forcement To Fight Sex Trafficking Demand Act of
6 2025”.

1 **SEC. 2. ADDITIONAL AUTHORIZED USE OF BYRNE JAG**
2 **FUNDS.**

3 Section 501(a)(1) of the Omnibus Crime Control and
4 Safe Streets Act of 1968 (34 U.S.C. 10152(a)(1)) is
5 amended by adding at the end the following:

6 “(I) Programs to combat human traf-
7 ficking (including programs to reduce the de-
8 mand for trafficked persons).”.

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
