A BILL

To direct the Secretary of Health and Human Services to dedicate sufficient resources for the support of LGBTQ+ youth seeking help from the 9–8–8 suicide prevention hotline, and for other purposes.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.**

4 This Act may be cited as the “988 LGBTQ+ Youth
5 Access Act of 2025”.

6 **SEC. 2. FINDINGS.**

7 Congress finds that—

1 (1) according to the Centers for Disease Con-
2 trol and Prevention, 45 percent of high school stu-
3 dents who seriously considered attempting suicide in
4 2021 identified as LGBTQ+;

5 (2) since its launch, Specialized Services for
6 LGBTQ+ youth within the 988 Suicide Prevention
7 and Crisis Lifeline have received over 1,500,000
8 calls, texts, and chats, with an average of 2,200 con-
9 tacts per day as of May 2025; and

10 (3) given that LGBTQ+ youth are four times
11 more likely to attempt suicide as compared to their
12 peers, Specialized Services for LGBTQ+ youth are
13 equipped with crucial training addressing LGBTQ+
14 specific challenges and needs.

15 **SEC. 3. SUICIDE PREVENTION HOTLINE SERVICES FOR**
16 **LGBTQ+ YOUTH.**

17 (a) IN GENERAL.—Section 520E–3(b) of the Public
18 Health Service Act (42 U.S.C. 290bb–36c(b)) is amend-
19 ed—

20 (1) in paragraph (4), by striking “and” at the
21 end;

22 (2) in paragraph (5), by striking the period at
23 the end and inserting “; and”; and

24 (3) by adding at the end the following:

1 “(6) dedicating sufficient resources, including
2 establishing, re-establishing, operating, and main-
3 taining specialized services (known as the Press 3
4 option or Integrated Voice Response (IVR)), for the
5 support of youth who are lesbian, gay, bisexual,
6 transgender, queer, or questioning (LGBTQ+) seek-
7 ing help from the suicide prevention hotline.”.

8 (b) FUNDING.—Section 520E–3(f) of such Act (42
9 U.S.C. 290bb–36c(f)) is amended by adding at the end
10 the following: “Of the amounts appropriated under this
11 subsection for a fiscal year, the Secretary shall reserve not
12 less than 9 percent for carrying out subsection (b)(6).”.
