A BILL

To direct the President to withdraw the United States from the Constitution of the World Health Organization, and for other purposes.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.**

4 This Act may be cited as the “WHO Withdrawal
5 Act”.

1 **SEC. 2. WITHDRAWAL OF UNITED STATES FROM THE CON-**
2 **STITUTION OF THE WORLD HEALTH ORGANI-**
3 **ZATION; PROHIBITION ON USE OF FUNDS.**

4 Effective on the date of the enactment of this Act—

5 (1) the President shall withdraw the United
6 States from the Constitution of the World Health
7 Organization (62 Stat. 2679; 14 U.N.T.S 186); and

8 (2) no funds available to any Federal depart-
9 ment or agency may used to provide for the partici-
10 pation of the United States in the World Health Or-
11 ganization or any successor organization.

12 **SEC. 3. REPEAL OF THE ACT OF JUNE 14, 1948.**

13 The Act of June 14, 1948 (Public Law 806–43; 62
14 Stat. 441; 22 U.S.C. 290 et seq.), providing for member-
15 ship and participation by the United States in the World
16 Health Organization and authorizing an appropriation
17 therefor, is repealed.
