3 **SECTION 1. ADDITIONAL SUBSIDIZATION.**

4 Section 603(i)(1)(B) of the Federal Water Pollution
5 Control Act (33 U.S.C. 1383(i)(1)(B)) is amended to read
6 as follows:

7 “(B) to implement or utilize a process, ma-
8 terial, technique, or technology (including soft-
9 ware for asset management, software for oper-

1 ational analysis, and advanced digital construc-
2 tion management systems)—
3 “(iii) to address water-efficiency goals;
4 “(iv) to address energy-efficiency
5 goals;
6 “(v) to mitigate stormwater runoff; or
7 “(vi) to implement projects that are
8 cost-effective and sustainably planned, de-
9 signed, and constructed.”.

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
