A BILL

To amend the Higher Education Act of 1965 to require institutions of higher education to track and record additional information on hate crimes, and for other purposes.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.**

4 This Act may be cited as the “Combating Hate
5 Across Campus Act”.

1 **SEC. 2. DISCLOSURE OF CAMPUS SECURITY POLICY AND**
2 **CAMPUS CRIME STATISTICS.**

3 Section 485(f)(1)(F)(ii) of the Higher Education Act
4 of 1965 (20 U.S.C. 1092(f)(1)(F)(ii)) is amended by strik-
5 ing “which data shall be collected and reported according
6 to category of prejudice;” and inserting “which data
7 shall—

8 “(I) be collected and reported accord-
9 ing to category of prejudice; and

10 “(II) disaggregated by subcategory
11 based on the identity of the targeted indi-
12 vidual or group, as listed in the most re-
13 cently available Hate Crime Data Collec-
14 tion Guidelines and Training Manual pub-
15 lished by the Criminal Justice Information
16 Services Division of the Federal Bureau of
17 Investigation;”.

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
