A BILL

To provide for the applicability of the Federal Performance Based Detention Standards to any immigration detention facility.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.**

4 This Act may be cited as the “Equal Detention
5 Standards Act of 2025”.

6 **SEC. 2. APPLICABILITY OF FEDERAL PERFORMANCE**
7 **BASED DETENTION STANDARDS.**

8 Beginning on the date of enactment of this Act, in
9 the case of any agreement entered into or renewed be-
10 tween the Secretary of Homeland Security and any entity

1 for the operation of a facility where, pursuant to any con-
2 tract or agreement, any individual is detained pursuant
3 to the immigration laws (as such term is defined in section
4 101 of the Immigration and Nationality Act), in addition
5 to any standards for the operation of immigration deten-
6 tion facilities applicable pursuant to the terms of such con-
7 tract or agreement, the Federal Performance Based De-
8 tention Standards published by the United States Marshal
9 Service shall apply to the operation of such facility.

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
