A BILL

To amend titles 10 and 32, United States Code, to prohibit
the use of a member of the Armed Forces to enforce
the immigration laws.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.**

4 This Act may be cited as the “National Guard Proper
5 Use Act”.

6 **SEC. 2. PROHIBITION ON ENFORCEMENT OF IMMIGRATION**
7 **LAWS BY MEMBERS OF THE ARMED FORCES.**

8 (a) TITLE 10.—Chapter 49 of title 10, United States
9 Code, is amended by inserting after section 974 the fol-
10 lowing new section:

1 **“§ 975. Prohibition on enforcement of immigration**
2 **laws**

3 “In accordance with section 1385 of title 18 (com-
4 monly referred to as the ‘Posse Comitatus Act’), a member
5 of the Armed Forces may not be ordered to perform duty
6 under this title to enforce, or to support the enforcement
7 of, the immigration laws (as such term is defined in sec-
8 tion 101 of the Immigration and Nationality Act (8 U.S.C.
9 1101)).”.

10 (b) TITLE 32.—Chapter 3 of title 32, United States
11 Code, is amended by inserting after section 329 the fol-
12 lowing new section:

13 **“§ 330. Prohibition on enforcement of immigration**
14 **laws**

15 “In accordance with section 1385 of title 18 (com-
16 monly referred to as the ‘Posse Comitatus Act’), a member
17 of the National Guard may not be ordered to perform duty
18 under this title to enforce, or to support the enforcement
19 of, the immigration laws (as such term is defined in sec-
20 tion 101 of the Immigration and Nationality Act (8 U.S.C.
21 1101)).”.

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
