3 **SECTION 1. RULE RELATING TO MEDICATIONS FOR THE**
4 **TREATMENT OF OPIOID USE DISORDER.**

5 (a) IN GENERAL.—Except as provided by subsection
6 (b), the final rule of the Department of Health and
7 Human Services titled “Medications for the Treatment of

1 Opioid Use Disorder” (89 Fed. Reg. 7549; published Feb-
2 ruary 2, 2024) shall have no force or effect.

3 (b) EXCEPTION.—Subsection (a) shall not apply to
4 the portion of the final rule that makes modifications to
5 subpart B of part 8 of title 42, Code of Federal Regula-
6 tions (relating to accreditation of opioid treatment pro-
7 grams).
