Mr. BIGGS of Arizona introduced the following bill; which was referred to the
Committee on the Judiciary

A BILL

To make orders of removal publicly available, and for other
purposes.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.**

4 This Act may be cited as the “Deportation Disclosure
5 Act”.

6 **SEC. 2. PUBLICLY AVAILABLE ORDERS OF REMOVAL.**

7 Section 240 of the Immigration and Nationality Act
8 (8 U.S.C. 1229a) is amended—

9 (1) by redesignating subsection (e) as sub-
10 section (f); and

1 (2) by inserting after subsection (d) the fol-
2 lowing:

3 “(e) PUBLICATION OF FINAL ORDERS OF RE-
4 MOVAL.—The Secretary of Homeland Security shall pub-
5 lish on the website of the Department of Homeland Secu-
6 rity the name of each individual who has received a final
7 order of removal after the date of enactment of this sub-
8 section, along with—

9 “(1) a photograph of the individual;

10 “(2) any aliases of the individual; and

11 “(3) the last known State in which the indi-
12 vidual resided.”.

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
