A BILL

To provide for limitations on the implementation and enforcement of a global carbon tax with respect to the United States.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.**

4 This Act may be cited as the “UNtaxed Act”.

1 **SEC. 2. LIMITATION ON UNITED NATIONS TAXES, TARIFFS,**
2 **FEES, OR OTHER SUCH PENALTIES.**

3 No tax, tariff, fee, or other such penalty may be lev-
4 ied upon United States citizens or United States compa-
5 nies by the United Nations or any organization, special-
6 ized agency, commission, or other formally affiliated body
7 of the United Nations, unless such tax, tariff, fee, or other
8 such penalty is imposed under an agreement that is in
9 effect with respect to the United States and the Senate
10 has provided its advice and consent to ratification of the
11 agreement.

12 **SEC. 3. LIMITATION ON FUNDS RELATING TO GLOBAL CAR-**
13 **BON TAXES.**

14 No funds are authorized to be appropriated or other-
15 wise made available for—

16 (1) assessed or voluntary contributions of the
17 United States to the United Nations or any United
18 Nations-affiliated body that would be used to impose
19 a global carbon tax; or

20 (2) implementation or enforcement of such a
21 global carbon tax.

22 **SEC. 4. DEFINITION.**

23 In this Act, the term “global carbon tax” means a
24 tax imposed under a global fuel regime that—

1 (1) requires owners or operators of vessels to
2 reduce the level of greenhouse gases emitted by the
3 vessel; and

4 (2) imposes such a tax at set costs with respect
5 to such level of emission of greenhouse gases.

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
