A BILL

To require that national cemeteries be open to visitors on legal public holidays.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.**

4 This Act may be cited as the “National Cemetery Ac-
5 cess Act”.

1 **SEC. 2. NATIONAL CEMETERIES OPEN ON LEGAL PUBLIC**
2 **HOLIDAYS.**

3 Each national cemetery administered by the Depart-
4 ment of Defense, the Department of Veterans Affairs, or
5 the National Park Service shall be open to visitors on the
6 legal public holidays described in section 6103(a) of title
7 5, United States Code.
