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## A BILL

To amend title 38, United States Code, to direct the Secretary of Veterans Affairs to furnish an opioid antagonist to a veteran without requiring a prescription or copayment.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*  
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. PROVISION BY THE SECRETARY OF VETERANS**  
4 **AFFAIRS OF AN OPIOID ANTAGONIST TO A**  
5 **VETERAN.**

6 (a) REQUIREMENT.—Subchapter II of chapter 17 of  
7 title 38, United States Code, is amended by adding at the

1 end the following new section (and amending the table of  
2 sections at the beginning of such chapter accordingly):

3 **“§ 1720M. Opioid antagonists.**

4       “The Secretary shall furnish an opioid antagonist to  
5 a veteran without requiring a prescription.”.

6       (b) ELIMINATION OF COPAYMENT.—Section 1722A  
7 of such title is amended, in subsection (a)(4), by striking  
8 all that follows “veteran” and inserting a period.

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
