3 **SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.**

4 This Act may be cited as the “Tribal Internet Expan-
5 sion Act of 2025”.

1 **SEC. 2. UNIVERSAL SERVICE IN INDIAN COUNTRY AND**
2 **AREAS WITH HIGH POPULATIONS OF INDIAN**
3 **PEOPLE.**

5 1934 (47 U.S.C. 254(b)(3)) is amended by inserting “and
6 in Indian country (as defined in section 1151 of title 18,
7 United States Code) and areas with high populations of
8 Indian (as defined in section 19 of the Act of June 18,
9 1934 (Chapter 576; 48 Stat. 988; 25 U.S.C. 5129)) peo-
10 ple” after “high cost areas”.

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
