3 **SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.**

4 This Act may be cited as the “Agricultural Coopera-
5 tive Energy Savings Act of 2025”.

2 **STATES DEPARTMENT OF AGRICULTURE**
3 **PROGRAMS TO INCLUDE AGRICULTURAL CO-**
4 **OPERATIVES WITH FEWER THAN 2,500 EM-**
5 **PLOYEES.**

8 is amended by inserting “, agricultural cooperatives with
9 less than 2,500 employees,” before “and rural”.

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
