A BILL

To amend title XVIII of the Social Security Act to require the Secretary of Health and Human Services to maintain a website for Medicare beneficiaries to search for providers participating in MA plans and traditional Medicare.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

1 **SECTION 1. REQUIRING WEBSITE FOR PROVIDER**
2 **SEARCHES UNDER THE MEDICARE PRO-**
3 **GRAM.**

4 Section 1851(d) of the Social Security Act is amend-
5 ed—

6 (1) in paragraph (7), by inserting “and mainte-
7 nance of the website required under paragraph (8)”
8 after “paragraph (2)(A)”; and

9 (2) by adding at the end the following new
10 paragraph:

11 “(8) WEBSITE FOR PROVIDER SEARCH.—Begin-
12 ning not later than 1 year after the date of the en-
13 actment of this paragraph, the Secretary shall main-
14 tain an internet website for Medicare beneficiaries
15 (and prospective Medicare beneficiaries) to—

16 “(A) search for providers of services and
17 suppliers participating in the network of an MA
18 plan or the original Medicare fee-for-service
19 program under parts A and B; and

20 “(B) identify the providers of services and
21 suppliers participating in the network of each
22 MA plan and the original Medicare fee-for-serv-
23 ice program under parts A and B.”.
