A BILL

To repeal the Alien Enemies Act, and for other purposes.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.**

4 This Act may be cited as the “Neighbors Not En-
5 emies Act”.

1 **SEC. 2. REPEAL OF ALIEN ENEMIES ACT.**

2 Sections 4067 through 4070 of the Revised Statutes
3 of the United States (50 U.S.C. 21–24) are repealed.

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
