Mr. GOTTHEIMER (for himself and Mr. LAWLER) introduced the following bill;
which was referred to the Committee on Energy and Commerce

A BILL

To direct the Secretary of Health and Human Services to establish a Lung Cancer Task Force, and for other purposes.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.**

4 This Act may be cited as the “Benay Taub Lung
5 Cancer Research Act”.

6 **SEC. 2. LUNG CANCER TASK FORCE.**

7 (a) ESTABLISHMENT.—The Secretary of Health and
8 Human Services shall establish a task force, to be known
9 as the Lung Cancer Task Force, within the National Insti-
10 tutes of Health.

1 (b) MEMBERSHIP.—The members of the task force
2 shall be appointed by the Secretary, and shall include—

3 (1) at least one representative of the National
4 Cancer Institute; and

5 (2) at least one representative of the National
6 Comprehensive Cancer Control Program of the Cen-
7 ters for Disease Control and Prevention.

8 (c) DUTIES.—The task force shall examine—

9 (1) disparities in lung cancer research, funding,
10 and patient access to treatments as compared to
11 other diseases, taking into account the number of
12 people affected by lung cancer;

13 (2) the level of Federal funding for lung cancer
14 research in relation to the burden caused by the dis-
15 ease; and

16 (3) lung cancer screenings in the United States.

17 (d) REPORT TO CONGRESS.—Not later than 180 days
18 after the date of enactment of this Act, the Secretary shall
19 transmit to Congress a report containing the findings and
20 recommendations of the task force, including rec-
21 ommendations for increasing the level of Federal funding
22 for lung cancer research.

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
