3 **SECTION 1. CONGRESSMAN GERALD E. CONNOLLY POST**
4 **OFFICE BUILDING.**

5 (a) DESIGNATION.—The facility of the United States
6 Postal Service located at 10660 Page Avenue in Fairfax,

1 Virginia, shall be known and designated as the “Congress-
2 man Gerald E. Connolly Post Office Building”.

3 (b) REFERENCES.—Any reference in a law, map, reg-
4 ulation, document, paper, or other record of the United
5 States to the facility referred to in subsection (a) shall
6 be deemed to be a reference to the “Congressman Gerald
7 E. Connolly Post Office Building”.

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
