Mr. CISNEROS introduced the following bill; which was referred to the

A BILL

To direct the Comptroller General of the United States to study the feasibility of a program to recruit individuals to serve for one year on active duty in the Armed Forces.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.**

4 This Act may be cited as the “Gateways to Advance-
5 ment and Preparedness for Military Service Act” or the
6 “GAP for Military Service Act”.

1 **SEC. 2. GAO FEASIBILITY STUDY ON PROGRAM TO RECRUIT**
2 **INDIVIDUALS TO SERVE FOR ONE YEAR ON**
3 **ACTIVE DUTY IN THE ARMED FORCES.**

4 Not later than one year after the date of the enact-
5 ment of this Act, the Comptroller General of the United
6 States shall submit to the Committees on Armed Services
7 of the Senate and House of Representatives a report re-
8 garding the feasibility of a program to recruit individuals
9 to serve for one year on active duty in the Armed Forces.
10 Such report shall include the following elements:

11 (1) A list of military occupational specialties
12 suitable for such program.

13 (2) The advanced training requirements for
14 such program.

15 (3) An evaluation of such programs in other
16 countries, including the effects on recruitment, re-
17 tention, and force effectiveness.

18 (4) A description of what such service may en-
19 tail.

20 (5) An assessment of the costs to implement
21 such a program.

22 (6) Barriers to implementing a such a program,
23 including the availability of data required to assess
24 the effectiveness of such program.
