# H. R. 6470

To amend the Congressional Budget and Impoundment Control Act of 1974 to require the Congressional Budget Office to provide baseline updates, and for other purposes.

Mr. MOORE of Utah (for himself, Mr. CLINE, Mr. EDWARDS, and Mr. CARTER of Georgia) introduced the following bill; which was referred to the Committee on the Budget

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## A BILL

To amend the Congressional Budget and Impoundment Control Act of 1974 to require the Congressional Budget Office to provide baseline updates, and for other purposes.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*  
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.**

4 This Act may be cited as the “Increasing Baseline  
5 Updates Act”.

1 **SEC. 2. CONGRESSIONAL BUDGET OFFICE UPDATES TO**  
2 **BASELINE.**

3 Section 202(e) of the Congressional Budget and Im-  
4 poundment Control Act of 1974 (2 U.S.C. 602(e)) is  
5 amended by adding at the end the following:

6 “(4)(A) Unless directed otherwise by the chairs  
7 of the Committees on the Budget of the House of  
8 Representatives and the Senate, the Director shall,  
9 to the extent practicable, submit to such committees  
10 at least two updates to the report submitted under  
11 paragraph (1), at least one of which shall include  
12 economic data used by the Director to calculate such  
13 update.

14 “(B) Nothing in this paragraph shall be con-  
15 strued to limit the Director from providing any other  
16 update to the baseline during such year.”.

17 **SEC. 3. ANNUAL TECHNICAL BUDGET DATA SUBMISSION BY**  
18 **THE PRESIDENT.**

19 Section 1106 of title 31, United States Code, is  
20 amended by adding at the end the following:

21 “(d) To the extent practicable, on or before February  
22 1 of each calendar year, the President shall submit to Con-  
23 gress technical budget data for the fiscal year beginning  
24 in the ensuing calendar year, which shall include up-to-  
25 date estimates for current year and prior year data and

- 1 credit reestimates for the current year (as included in the
- 2 Federal credit supplement of such budget).”.
