Mr. TORRES of New York (for himself and Ms. CLARKE of New York) introduced the following bill; which was referred to the Committee on Natural Resources

A BILL

To amend the Federal Lands Recreation Enhancement Act to waive entrance fees to national parks on Federal holidays, and for other purposes.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.**

4 This Act may be cited as the “Our Parks Act”.

5 **SEC. 2. WAIVER OF ENTRANCE FEES ON FEDERAL HOLI-**
6 **DAYS.**

7 Section 803(e) of the Federal Lands Recreation En-
8 hancement Act (16 U.S.C. 6802(e)) is amended by adding
9 at the end the following:

1 “(3) FEDERAL HOLIDAYS.—For each unit of
2 the National Park System or National Wildlife Ref-
3 uge System at which an entrance fee is charged
4 under paragraph (1), the Secretary shall not charge
5 an entrance fee for entrance on a Federal holiday
6 listed in section 6103 of title 5, United States
7 Code.”.
