A BILL

To authorize a major medical facility project for the Department of Veterans Affairs for fiscal year 2026 in St. Louis, Missouri, and for other purposes.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.**

4 This Act may be cited as the “Fiscal Year 2025 Vet-
5 erans Affairs Major Medical Facility Authorization Act”.

1 **SEC. 2. AUTHORIZATION OF MAJOR MEDICAL FACILITY**
2 **PROJECT OF DEPARTMENT OF VETERANS AF-**
3 **FAIRS FOR FISCAL YEAR 2026 IN ST. LOUIS,**
4 **MISSOURI.**

5 (a) IN GENERAL.—The Secretary of Veterans Affairs
6 may carry out a major medical facility project in fiscal
7 year 2026 in St. Louis, Missouri, that consists of the con-
8 struction of a new bed tower, clinical building expansion,
9 consolidated administrative building and warehouse, util-
10 ity plant, and parking garages, in an amount not to exceed
11 \$1,762,668,000.

12 (b) AUTHORIZATION OF APPROPRIATIONS.—There is
13 authorized to be appropriated to the Secretary of Veterans
14 Affairs for fiscal year 2026 or the year in which funds
15 are appropriated for the Construction, Major Projects ac-
16 count, \$1,762,668,000 for the project authorized in sub-
17 section (a).

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
