Mrs. LUNA introduced the following bill; which was referred to the Committee on Homeland Security

A BILL

To exempt Members of the House of Representatives and Senators of the Senate from certain Federal passenger and baggage screening, and for other purposes.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. EXEMPTION OF MEMBERS AND SENATORS**
4 **FROM CERTAIN FEDERAL PASSENGER AND**
5 **BAGGAGE SCREENING.**

6 (a) IN GENERAL.—Subsection (a) of section 218 of
7 the Further Consolidated Appropriations Act, 2024 (Pub-
8 lic Law 118–47) is amended by striking “Members of the
9 United States House of Representatives and the United

1 States Senate, including the leadership; the heads” and
2 inserting “The heads”.

3 (b) NONAPPLICABILITY.—Subsection (b) of section
4 218 of the Further Consolidated Appropriations Act, 2024
5 shall not apply to the amendment made by subsection (a)
6 and shall not have any force or effect at law relating there-
7 to.

8 (c) EXEMPTION.—The Administrator of the Trans-
9 portation Security Administration shall exempt a Member
10 of the House of Representatives or a Senator of the Sen-
11 ate, including the leadership of either of such House, from
12 Federal passenger and baggage screening if such Member
13 or Senator, as the case may be, is traveling between the
14 home airport of such Member or Senator, as the case may
15 be, and any other location.

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
