A BILL

To amend title 54, United States Code, apply certain National Historic Preservation Act requirements to the White House, and for other purposes.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.**

4 This Act may be cited as the “People’s White House
5 Historic Preservation Act”.

1 **SEC. 2. INAPPLICABILITY OF DIVISION.**

2 Section 307104 of title 54, United States Code, is
3 amended—

4 (1) by striking “the White House or its
5 grounds”; and

6 (2) by striking “, or” and inserting “or”.

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
