A BILL

3 **SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.**

4 This Act may be cited as the “FEMA Administrative
5 Reform Act”.

1 **SEC. 2. FEMA ADMINISTRATIVE REFORM.**

2 Notwithstanding any other provision of law, the Sec-
3 retary of Homeland Security may not implement any pol-
4 icy that would require the personal approval of the Sec-
5 retary of any expenditure of the Federal Emergency Man-
6 agement Agency of more than \$100,000 for disaster-re-
7 lated costs.

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
