3 **SECTION 1. FEDERAL MONITOR AND RECEIVER TESTI-**
4 **MONY.**

5 Not later than October 1 of each year, any Federal
6 monitor or receiver that has provided oversight of a public
7 housing agency (as such term is defined in section 3(b)

1 of the United States Housing Act of 1937 (42 U.S.C.
2 1437a(b))) in the previous year shall appear before the
3 Committee on Financial Services of the House of Rep-
4 resentatives and the Committee on Banking, Housing, and
5 Urban Affairs of the Senate and present testimony on
6 management oversight of the Federal monitor or receiver.

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
