Ms. VELÁZQUEZ introduced the following bill; which was referred to the Committee on Financial Services, and in addition to the Committee on Foreign Affairs, for a period to be subsequently determined by the Speaker, in each case for consideration of such provisions as fall within the jurisdiction of the committee concerned

A BILL

To require the Comptroller General of the United States to study and report to the Congress on the 2025 financial crisis in Argentina.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.**

4 This Act may be cited as the “Argentina Bailout
5 Oversight Act”.

1 **SEC. 2. GAO REPORT.**

2 (a) STUDY.—The Comptroller General of the United
3 States shall conduct a study of the 2025 financial crisis
4 in Argentina.

5 (b) SCOPE.—The study shall include—

6 (1) an examination on the origins of Argen-
7 tina’s financial crisis;

8 (2) an assessment of the extent to which the
9 United States Government and the International
10 Monetary Fund have been aware of Argentina’s fi-
11 nancial problems and provided relevant advice to Ar-
12 gentina;

13 (3) a description of the United States and
14 international response to the crisis, including an as-
15 sessment of the terms and conditions of the agree-
16 ments implementing United States assistance to ad-
17 dress the crisis;

18 (4) an analysis of the statutory authority of the
19 Secretary of the Treasury to use the Exchange Sta-
20 bilization Fund to fund United States assistance;
21 and

22 (5) an examination of the efforts of Argentina
23 to recover from the crisis.

24 (c) REPORT TO CONGRESS.—Within 18 months after
25 the date of the enactment of this Act, the Comptroller
26 General shall submit to the Committee on Financial Serv-

1 ices of the House of Representatives and the Committee
2 on Banking, Housing, and Urban Affairs of the Senate
3 a report containing the findings and conclusions of the
4 study required by subsection (b).

5 (d) PUBLICATION.—After submitting the report re-
6 quired by subsection (c), the Comptroller General shall
7 make the report publicly available on the website of the
8 Government Accountability Office.

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
