A BILL

To amend title XVIII of the Social Security Act to permit additional accrediting organizations to approve specialized MA plans for special needs individuals.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.**

4 This Act may be cited as the “Improving MA SNP
5 Act of 2026”.

1 **SEC. 2. ACCREDITATION OF SPECIALIZED MA PLANS FOR**
2 **SPECIAL NEEDS INDIVIDUALS.**

3 Section 1859(f)(7) of the Social Security Act (42
4 U.S.C. 1395w-28(f)(7)) is amended—

5 (1) in the heading, by striking “NCQA AP-
6 PROVED” and inserting “APPROVED BY AN ACCRED-
7 ITING ORGANIZATION”;

8 (2) by inserting “, based on standards estab-
9 lished by the Secretary,” after “approved”; and

10 (3) by striking “(based on standards estab-
11 lished by the Secretary)” and inserting “or, for 2026
12 and subsequent years, by any other private accred-
13 iting organization with an application approved
14 under section 1852(e)(4)(C) determined appropriate
15 by the Secretary”.
