A BILL

To prohibit the Administrator of General Services from awarding contracts for certain commercial payment systems under the SmartPay Program, and for other purposes.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.**

4 This Act may be cited as the “No SmartPay for Anti-
5 2A Companies Act”.

1 **SEC. 2. PROHIBITION ON AWARDING CONTRACTS FOR CER-**
2 **TAIN COMMERCIAL PAYMENT SYSTEMS**
3 **UNDER THE SMARTPAY PROGRAM.**

4 (a) IN GENERAL.—The Administrator of General
5 Services may not award a contract under the SmartPay
6 Program for the procurement of a commercial payment
7 system that uses a payment processing agency that has
8 implemented a merchant category code for gun retailers.

9 (b) APPLICABILITY.—This Act shall not apply to any
10 contract awarded before the date of the enactment of this
11 Act.

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
