Mr. SHERMAN (for himself and Ms. NORTON) introduced the following bill; which was referred to the Committee on Foreign Affairs, and in addition to the Committee on Armed Services, for a period to be subsequently determined by the Speaker, in each case for consideration of such provisions as fall within the jurisdiction of the committee concerned

A BILL

To prohibit the United States from deploying or otherwise assigning any troops for duty to Greenland except at the invitation of the Kingdom of Denmark, and for other purposes.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.**

4 This Act may be cited as the “Hands Off Greenland
5 Act”.

1 SEC. 2. PROHIBITION ON SENDING TROOPS.

2 On and after the date of the enactment of this Act,
3 the President may not deploy or otherwise assign any
4 member of the United States Armed Forces for duty to
5 Greenland except in response to an explicit invitation of
6 the Kingdom of Denmark. No Federal funds are author-
7 ized to be made available to deploy or otherwise assign
8 such troops on or after such date of enactment, except
9 those deployed at the explicit invitation of the Kingdom
10 of Denmark.
