A BILL

To amend the Public Works and Economic Development Act of 1965 to provide for certain grant eligibility relating to projects that facilitate the relocation, to the United States, of a source of employment located outside the United States, and for other purposes.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*
 2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.**

4 *This Act may be cited as the “Made in America Jobs*
 5 *Act of 2026”.*

6 **SEC. 2. GRANTS FOR PUBLIC WORKS AND ECONOMIC DE-**
 7 **VELOPMENT.**

8 *(a) GRANTS FOR PUBLIC WORKS AND ECONOMIC DE-*
 9 *VELOPMENT.—Section 201(c) of the Public Works and Eco-*
 10 *nomie Development Act of 1965 (42 U.S.C. 3141(c)) is*
 11 *amended—*

12 *(1) in paragraph (7) by striking “or” at the end;*

13 *(2) in paragraph (8) by striking the period at*
 14 *the end and inserting a semicolon; and*

15 *(3) by adding at the end the following:*

16 *“(9) facilitate the relocation, to the United*
 17 *States, of a source of employment located outside the*
 18 *United States; and*

19 *“(10) facilitate the growth of the manufacturing*
 20 *sector.”.*

21 *(b) GRANTS FOR PLANNING AND GRANTS FOR ADMIN-*
 22 *ISTRATIVE EXPENSES.—Section 203(a) of the Public Works*
 23 *and Economic Development Act of 1965 (42 U.S.C.*
 24 *3143(a)) is amended by inserting “, including planning*
 25 *with respect to projects to facilitate the relocation, to the*

1 *United States, of a source of employment located outside*
 2 *the United States or to facilitate the growth of the manufac-*
 3 *turing sector,” after “economic development planning”.*

4 (c) *GRANTS FOR TRAINING, RESEARCH, AND TECH-*
 5 *NICAL ASSISTANCE.*—Section 207(a)(2) of the Public Works
 6 and Economic Development Act of 1965 (42 U.S.C.
 7 3147(a)(2)) is amended—

8 (1) in subparagraph (H) by striking “and” at
 9 the end;

10 (2) by redesignating subparagraph (I) as sub-
 11 paragraph (K); and

12 (3) by inserting after subparagraph (H) the fol-
 13 lowing:

14 “(I) activities to facilitate the relocation, to
 15 the United States, of a source of employment lo-
 16 cated outside the United States;

17 “(J) activities to facilitate the growth of the
 18 manufacturing sector; and”.

19 (d) *GRANTS FOR ECONOMIC ADJUSTMENT.*—Section
 20 209(a) of the Public Works and Economic Development Act
 21 of 1965 (42 U.S.C. 3149(a)) is amended by inserting
 22 “projects to facilitate the relocation, to the United States,
 23 of a source of employment located outside the United States,
 24 projects to facilitate the growth of the manufacturing sec-
 25 tor,” after “loan fund),”.
