A BILL

To require the Director of the United States Fish and Wildlife Service to provide an opportunity for public notice and comment with respect to land protection plans.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.**

4 This Act may be cited as the “Transparency in Fed-
5 eral Land Acquisitions Act”.

6 **SEC. 2. NOTICE AND COMMENT FOR LAND PROTECTION**
7 **PLANS.**

8 (a) IN GENERAL.—Notwithstanding section 553(a)
9 of title 5, United States Code, when preparing a land pro-

1 tection plan, the Director of the United States Fish and
2 Wildlife Service shall—

3 (1) not less than 60 days before the date on
4 which the land protection plan is finalized, publish
5 the proposed land protection plan in the Federal
6 Register; and

7 (2) after the publication required by paragraph
8 (1), give interested persons an opportunity to com-
9 ment on the draft land protection plan through sub-
10 mission of written data, views, or arguments.

11 (b) EXCEPTION.—Subsection (a) shall not apply with
12 respect to a land protection plan for a proposed expansion
13 to a unit of the National Wildlife Refuge System if such
14 expansion is comprised of a total acreage less than the
15 greater of the following:

16 (1) 50 acres.

17 (2) 15 percent of the total acreage of the unit.

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
