A BILL

To amend title XVIII of the Social Security Act to provide coverage for wigs as durable medical equipment under the Medicare program, and for other purposes.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. PROVIDING COVERAGE FOR WIGS AS DURABLE**
4 **MEDICAL EQUIPMENT UNDER THE MEDI-**
5 **CARE PROGRAM.**

6 (a) IN GENERAL.—Section 1861(n) of the Social Se-
7 curity Act (42 U.S.C. 1395x(n)) is amended by adding
8 at the end the following new sentence: “Such term also

1 includes cranial prostheses furnished to an individual, but
2 only where the dermatologist, oncologist, or attending phy-
3 sician of the individual certifies in writing the medical ne-
4 cessity of such prostheses as part of a proposed course
5 of rehabilitative treatment or for hair loss caused by a
6 health condition, including autoimmune diseases, cancer,
7 or chemotherapy.”.

8 (b) CONFORMING AMENDMENT.—Section 1862(a)(1)
9 of the Social Security Act (42 U.S.C. 1395y(a)(1)) is
10 amended—

11 (1) in subparagraph (O), by striking “and” at
12 the end;

13 (2) in subparagraph (P), by striking the semi-
14 colon and inserting “, and”; and

15 (3) by adding at the end the following new sub-
16 paragraph:

17 “(Q) in the case of cranial prostheses (as described
18 in section 1861(n)), which are not certified in the manner
19 described in such section;”.
