3 **SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.**

4 This Act may be cited as the “Curtailing Agency
5 Reach and Bureaucracy Overreach on Net-Zero Act” or
6 the “CARBON Act”.

7 **SEC. 2. EXCLUSION OF CARBON DIOXIDE, METHANE, AND**
8 **NITROUS OXIDE.**

9 Section 302(g) of the Clean Air Act (42 U.S.C.
10 7602(g)) is amended by adding at the end “Such term
