## A BILL

To authorize the consolidation of reports required to be submitted by the Bureau of Global Health Security and Diplomacy of the Department of State, and for other purposes.

1       *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*  
2       *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3       **SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.**

4       This Act may be cited as the “Advance Global Health  
5       Act”.

6       **SEC. 2. AUTHORIZATION FOR CONSOLIDATION.**

7       (a) ANNUAL CONSOLIDATION.—On and after the  
8       date of the enactment of this Act and except as provided

1 in subsection (b), each report required to be submitted to  
2 Congress or to any committee of Congress that is pro-  
3 duced by the Bureau of Global Health Security and Diplo-  
4 macy of the Department of State shall be consolidated into  
5 a single annual report that is submitted not later than  
6 September 30 of each year. Such consolidated report shall  
7 be submitted in a machine-searchable format and contain  
8 all statutorily required information.

9 (b) EXCEPTIONS.—The consolidation required by  
10 subsection (a) shall be subject to the following exceptions:

11 (1) With respect to any report that cannot be  
12 consolidated into the annual report during the 1-  
13 year period beginning on the date of the enactment  
14 of this Act without the loss of required information,  
15 the Ambassador at Large for the Bureau of Global  
16 Health Security and Diplomacy shall include a no-  
17 tice in the consolidated annual report naming the ex-  
18 cluded report and certifying that the report shall be  
19 made available on the statutorily required due date.

20 (2) Any report required to be submitted on a  
21 quarterly basis and any report required in advance  
22 of the expenditure of funds related to the budget of  
23 the Department may not be consolidated into the  
24 annual report under subsection (a).

1       (c) RULE OF CONSTRUCTION.—Nothing in this Act  
2 may be construed to waive, alter, or affect any require-  
3 ment to provide congressional notification.
