A BILL

To require a report that describes the current restrictions imposed by the Taliban on women and girls in Afghanistan since August 2021.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.**

4 This Act may be cited as the “Rejecting the Erasure
5 of Afghan Women and Girls Act”.

6 **SEC. 2. REPORT.**

7 Not later than 180 days after the date of the enact-
8 ment of this Act, the Secretary of State shall submit to
9 the Committee on Foreign Affairs of the House of Rep-

1 representatives and the Committee on Foreign Relations of
2 the Senate a report that—

3 (1) describes the current restrictions imposed
4 by the Taliban on women and girls in Afghanistan
5 since August 2021; and

6 (2) includes a determination as to whether the
7 restrictions described in paragraph (1) are—

8 (A) crimes against humanity;

9 (B) torture, as defined in the Convention
10 against Torture and Other Cruel, Inhumane, or
11 De-grading Treatment; or

12 (C) gross violations of human rights, as
13 defined in the Foreign Assistance Act of 1961.
