Mr. MOYLAN introduced the following bill; which was referred to the
Committee on the Judiciary

A BILL

To amend the Radiation Exposure Compensation Act to
include Guam.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.**

4 This Act may be cited as the “Parity for Pacific Ra-
5 diation Survivors Act”.

6 **SEC. 2. ATMOSPHERIC TESTING IN THE PACIFIC.**

7 Section 4(b)(1) of the Radiation Exposure Com-
8 pensation Act (Public Law 101–426; 42 U.S.C. 2210
9 note) is amended—

10 (1) in subparagraph (A)—

1 (A) in the matter preceding clause (i), by
 2 striking “subparagraph (B)” and inserting
 3 “subparagraphs (B) and (C)”;

4 (B) in clause (ii), by striking “and” at the
 5 end; and

6 (C) by adding at the end the following:

7 “(iv) the territory of Guam;”; and

8 (2) by adding at the end the following:

9 “(C) with respect to a claim by an indi-
 10 vidual under subsection (a)(1)(A)(i)(IV) or
 11 (a)(2)(D), only Guam.”.

12 **SEC. 3. LEUKEMIA CLAIMS RELATING TO TESTS IN THE PA-**
 13 **CIFIC.**

14 Section 4(a)(1)(A) of the Radiation Exposure Com-
 15 pensation Act (Public Law 101-426; 42 U.S.C. 2210
 16 note) is amended—

17 (1) in clause (i)—

18 (A) in subclause (III), by striking “or” at
 19 the end;

20 (B) by redesignating subclause (IV) as
 21 subclause (VI); and

22 (C) by inserting after subclause (III) the
 23 following:

24 “(IV) was physically present in
 25 an affected area—

1 “(aa) for a period of at least
2 1 year during the period begin-
3 ning on July 1, 1946, and ending
4 on November 6, 1992; or

5 “(bb) for the period begin-
6 ning on April 25, 1962, and end-
7 ing on November 6, 1962;

8 “(V) was a member of the Armed
9 Forces who participated onsite in the
10 radiological cleanup of Enewetak Atoll
11 for any period of time during the pe-
12 riod beginning on May 1, 1977, and
13 ending on May 31, 1980; or”; and

14 (2) in clause (ii), by striking “subclause (I),
15 (II), or (III) of clause (i) or onsite participation de-
16 scribed in clause (i)(IV)” and inserting “subclause
17 (I), (II), (III), or (IV) of clause (i) or onsite partici-
18 pation described in subclause (V) or (VI) of clause
19 (i)”.

20 **SEC. 4. SPECIFIED DISEASES CLAIMS RELATING TO TESTS**
21 **IN THE PACIFIC.**

22 (a) IN GENERAL.—Section 4(a)(2) of the Radiation
23 Exposure Compensation Act (Public Law 101–426; 42
24 U.S.C. 2210 note) is amended—

1 (1) in subparagraph (C), by striking “or” at
2 the end;

3 (2) by redesignating subparagraph (D) as sub-
4 paragraph (F); and

5 (3) by inserting after subparagraph (C) the fol-
6 lowing:

7 “(D) was physically present in an affected
8 area—

9 “(i) for a period of at least 1 year
10 during the period beginning on July 1,
11 1946, and ending on November 21, 1992;
12 or

13 “(ii) for the period beginning on April
14 25, 1962, and ending on November 6,
15 1962;

16 “(E) was a member of the Armed Forces
17 who participated onsite in the radiological
18 cleanup of Enewetak Atoll for any period of
19 time during the period beginning on May 1,
20 1977, and ending on May 31, 1980; or”.

21 (b) INCLUSION OF RENAL DISEASES.—Section
22 4(b)(2) of the Radiation Exposure Compensation Act
23 (Public Law 101–426; 42 U.S.C. 2210 note) is amend-
24 ed—

- 1 (1) by inserting “renal disease,” after
- 2 “lymphomas (other than Hodgkin’s disease),”; and
- 3 (2) by striking “or lung” and inserting “lung,
- 4 or renal”.

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
