A BILL

To amend the Food Security Act of 1985 to repeal certain provisions relating to the acceptance and use of contributions for public-private partnerships, and for other purposes.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. ACCEPTANCE AND USE OF CONTRIBUTIONS.**

4 Section 1241(f) of the Food Security Act of 1985 (16
5 U.S.C. 3841(f)) is amended—

6 (1) in the subsection heading, by striking “FOR
7 PUBLIC-PRIVATE PARTNERSHIPS”;

1 (2) by amending paragraph (1) to read as fol-
2 lows:

3 “(1) AUTHORITY TO ESTABLISH CONTRIBUTION
4 ACCOUNTS.—Subject to paragraph (2), the Secretary
5 may establish a sub-account for each conservation
6 program administered by the Secretary under sub-
7 title D to accept contributions of non-Federal funds
8 to support the purposes of the program.”;

9 (3) in paragraph (2), by striking “a covered
10 program shall be deposited into the account” and in-
11 serting “a conservation program administered by the
12 Secretary under subtitle D shall be deposited into
13 the sub-account”; and

14 (4) by striking paragraphs (3) through (10).

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
