A BILL

To prohibit the Secretary of State from charging a fee for the issuance or reissuance of a passport card.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.**

4 This Act may be cited as the “American Passport
5 Card Accessibility Act”.

6 **SEC. 2. PROHIBITION ON FEES FOR PASSPORT CARDS.**

7 (a) PROHIBITION.—Notwithstanding section 1 of the
8 Act of June 1, 1920 (22 U.S.C. 214; commonly referred
9 to as the “Passport Act of 1920”), the Secretary of State

1 may not charge a fee for the issuance or reissuance of
2 a passport card.

3 (b) EXPEDITED PROCESSING FEES EXCEPTED.—

4 The prohibition in subsection (a) shall not apply to a fee
5 assessed for the expedited processing of an application for
6 issuance or reissuance of a passport card.
