A BILL

To amend title 38, United States Code, to improve the Department of Veterans Affairs schedule for rating disabilities, and for other purposes.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.**

4 This Act may be cited as the “Carlton H. Ingram
5 Veterans’ Benefits Improvement Act”.

6 **SEC. 2. IMPROVEMENTS TO DEPARTMENT OF VETERANS**
7 **AFFAIRS SCHEDULE FOR RATING DISABIL-**
8 **ITIES.**

9 Section 1155 of title 38, United States Code, is
10 amended—

1 (1) in the first sentence, by striking “The Sec-
2 retary” and inserting the following:

3 “(a) IN GENERAL.—The Secretary”; and

4 (2) by adding at the end the following new sub-
5 section:

6 “(b) BENEFICIAL EFFECTS OF MEDICATION OR
7 TREATMENT.—(1) The schedule of ratings adopted and
8 applied under subsection (a) shall be constructed to dis-
9 count the beneficial effects of medication or treatment,
10 when evidence can be used to establish a baseline without
11 those beneficial effects.

12 “(2) Paragraph (1) shall not be construed to preclude
13 a veteran from seeking compensation for additional dis-
14 abilities resulting from medication or treatment for an un-
15 derlying injury suffered or disease contracted in line of
16 duty, or for aggravation of a preexisting injury suffered
17 or disease contract in line of duty, in the active military,
18 naval, air, or space service.”.
