A BILL

To prohibit the use of funds to use military force in or
against Cuba, and for other purposes.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. PROHIBITION ON USE OF FORCE IN OR**
4 **AGAINST CUBA.**

5 (a) IN GENERAL.—Except as provided in subsection
6 (b), no funds appropriated or otherwise made available for
7 the Federal Government may be obligated or expended

1 during the period beginning on the date of the enactment
2 of this Act and ending on December 31, 2026, for any
3 use of military force in or against the Republic of Cuba
4 unless Congress has—

5 (1) declared war on Cuba; or

6 (2) enacted specific statutory authorization for
7 such use of military force after the date of the en-
8 actment of this Act that meets the requirements of
9 the War Powers Resolution (50 U.S.C. 1541 et
10 seq.).

11 (b) EXCEPTION.—The prohibition under subsection
12 (a) shall not apply to a use of military force that is con-
13 sistent with section 2(c) of the War Powers Resolution (50
14 U.S.C. 1541(c)).
