## A BILL

To reaffirm the Commodity Futures Trading Commission’s authority to enforce prohibited activity on prediction markets.

1        *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*  
2        *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3        **SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.**

4        This Act may be cited as the “Prediction Market Re-

5        strictions on Insider Speculation and Knowledge-Trading

6        Act” or the “Prediction Market RISK Act”.

7        **SEC. 2. DEFINITION.**

8        The term “prediction market contract” means any fi-

9        nancial instrument, contract, or derivative listed on or of-

10       fered by a platform engaged in interstate commerce and

1 tied to the occurrence or non-occurrence of a future event,  
2 including market-based event contracts.

3 **SEC. 3. CFTC AUTHORITY TO ENFORCE PROHIBITED**  
4 **TRANSACTIONS OCCURRING IN RELATION TO**  
5 **A PREDICTION MARKET CONTRACT.**

6 Section 4(c) and section 6(c) of the Commodity Ex-  
7 change Act (7 U.S.C. 7a-2(c)) apply to illegal trading  
8 practices occurring with relation to a prediction market  
9 contract.
